
Japan's biggest Vietnam event at Yoyogi Park



Artists from Japan, including Sunplaza Nakano, Ujigami Ichiban, Gypsy Queen, Milky Way, and the Oguri Kumiko Trio, will also take the stage, as well as Hai Trieu, a Vietnamese musician in Japan who recently resumed his artistic activities. And in celebration of the Japan-Mekong Exchange Year, the Japanese-Thai duo Sweet Vacation will be performing.
